ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

This Environmental Policy relates to FUJIFILM NZ Limited's operations at Albany in Auckland New Zealand.

FUJIFILM NZ Limited is part of the FUJIFILM Holdings Group. FUJIFILM NZ Limited is the official importer of Fuji products into New Zealand from Fujifilm Corporation of Tokyo, Japan.

No manufacturing is undertaken at FUJIFILM NZ Limited which is solely an importer and wholesaler of finished products, such as cameras, camera accessories, photographic film and paper, medical imaging equipment, minilabs and photographic processing chemicals and graphics equipment and consumables. Some of the imported Fuji products are re-packaged to suit the New Zealand market before dispatch from the FUJIFILM NZ Limited's warehouse.


The operation covers approximately 5900 square meters and employs around 65 full-time employees.

FUJIFILM NZ Limited's environmental commitments include:

- Prevention of pollution;
- Minimising raw material consumption, where possible;
- Maximising the amount of packaging that is re-used or re-cycled;
- Minimising the amount of solid waste going to landfill;
- Achieving compliance with environmental legislation and other obligations.

Management is committed to maintaining a management system that complies with the international standard for environmental management, ISO 14001.

FUJIFILM NZ Limited is committed to continual improvement, where possible, in its environmental performance.
